

Email from Colin Rockliff 22 January 2010

The University issued an Expression of Interest (EOI) on Friday 15 January 2010 to six (6) Architectural firms inviting each firm to submit an EOI and capability statement for the provision of Architectural Design Services for the Boatshed. The EOI submissions are due today.

The key role of the Architect will be to identify the requirements of the Boatshed and design to the most appropriate design brief. Also to assist in selection of the most appropriate site and very importantly achieve a high quality design solution deserving of a sensitive Harbour frontage project.

The engagement process is outlined below:

- Step 1: EOI submissions close - 22 January 2010;
- Step 2: Select shortlist (and issue Brief for Step 3) – 27 January 2010;
- Step 3: Design Approach and Fee Proposal (to complete DA submission) submissions close – 12 February 2010;
- Step 4: Select Architect 26 February 2010.

We expect that once an Architect is appointed a program of how the design process will proceed will be available by end March 2010 and I will be able to give you an update on our next steps.
